My role as the Digital Scholarship and Data Management Librarian at University Library is to provide research support services to IUPUI faculty, staff, and students. This role includes research data services, research metrics services, and liaison services to the School of Public Health. Research data services aim to promote responsible data stewardship by researchers, the Library, and the institution. I address topics such as research data management, preservation, and sharing requirements, research reproducibility, and data citation through individual consultations and a variety of workshops. In order

to facilitate data sharing and reuse, I manage the institutional data repository (IUPUI DataWorks). With the goal of facilitating institutional stewardship of research data, I collaborate with various University offices and research support units to develop guidance, share information about the needs of researchers, and to offer appropriate guidance to researchers across the University. Beyond research data services, I contribute to the mission of the Center for Digital Scholarship by engaging with faculty, staff, and students about dissemination of scholarly products including publications, data, code, and others. I advocate and educate faculty and students on traditional and emerging scholarly metrics for research evaluation. In partnership with other IUPUI librarians, I consult with faculty to facilitate informed use of citation and altmetrics in tenure and promotion dossiers.

I contribute to the research and teaching missions of the Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health by providing customized research support in the form of consultations and information literacy instruction, as well as building a collection of learning resources.
